**Re: CPSA Refusal to Allow Medical Exemptions based on “Informed Consent”**

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Please be advised that we represent numerous physicians who are concerned with regard to the CPSA’s view that physicians should subscribe to a narrow, thoughtless adherence to the COVID-19 Scientific Advisory Group Rapid Brief, “Medical Exemptions for COVID-19 Vaccine Jurisdiction Scan September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021”.

This is an AHS document that was prepared in large part to support AHS policies of constructively dismissing, or stripping privileges from staff or physicians who do not **CONSENT** to the COVID-19 vaccine. AHS has a clear conflict of interest in the promulgation of this document.

The SAG’s September 7, 2021, document is now several months behind the current science. Scientific evidence now indicates that natural immunity is superior to immunity obtained through mRNA vaccinations. Science now also indicates that the entire political narrative and rationale for mandatory vaccinations is completely undercut by evidence that indicates that the double-vaccinated are now able to contract and spread COVID-19 at rates equal to those who are unvaccinated.

The document expressly ignores the CPSA Standards of Care which state that the **MINIMUM** standard of care for any “medical treatment” or “procedure” in the Province of Alberta requires the patient’s “informed consent”. A lack of informed consent **IS** a medical reason for granting an exemption that was completely ignored by SAG.


